The Scarborough Chapter of Professional Engineers of Ontario is organizing the 10th Annual Mathletics competition. The event is scheduled to be held on Halloween day **Saturday, October 31st, 2015 at the Scarborough Civic Centre – Council Chambers** from 9:30am to 2:00pm. This year, the Mathletics competition will be a Halloween themed event, so the participants are welcomed to attend in their Halloween costumes.

Mathletics is a competition designed by engineers to demonstrate the application of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) in everyday life. The questions show the significance of Mathematics in Technology, Engineering and Science. Every question is preceded by a succinct explanation of scientific principles and concepts. The competition is a learning tool for children rather than a race to the highest score. Students will enjoy the competition while learning important concepts. Students answer questions by the use of 'remote answering devices' called clickers.
