The Scarborough Chapter of Professional Engineers of Ontario is organizing the 14th Annual Mathletics competition. The event is scheduled on **Saturday (October 26, 2019) at Scarborough Civic Centre – Council Chamber** from 9:30 am to 1:30 pm.

Mathletics competition is designed by engineers to demonstrate the application of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) in everyday life. The questions in the competition signify the importance of applied mathematics in technology, engineering and science. Every question is preceded by a succinct explanation of scientific principles and concepts. The competition is an active learning tool for children rather than a race to the highest score. Students' will enjoy the competition while learning important concepts. Answering the questions is done using a remote answering device – clickers.

There are prizes for students' and we encourage the teachers to register for the students and accompany them for the event.

There will be separate Mathletics competition for Juniors and Seniors on the same day. Juniors are students' from grades 5 to 6 and Seniors are students' of grades 7 and 8. Registration is on first come, first serve basis. We will allow a maximum of 60 students' to register in each level (60 students' for Juniors and 60 students' for Seniors) and the later students will be in waiting list. To avoid disappointment, please register your students at the earliest. Registrations will be accepted until **October 13, 2019**.
